Worthy Brothers, Families, Squires and Roses,

We can worship together again. At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit has touched us, and the Holy Trinity was celebrated and this Sunday it will be the Feast of Corpus Christi. All please thank God; we can sing again. Alleluia! We pray that the pandemic restrictions will be totally over in July. But this has been a Columbian year full of asterisks. It is a year of gracias and Altagracia...of thanks and Grace.

THANK YOU TO ALL OF YOU WHO BRAVED THE PANDEMIC WHO SERVED AND PRAYED WITH THE COUNCIL AT OUR EVENTS OR AT HOME.

There is a Mexican dicho which says you are who you walk with...thank you for walking with me this year. It has been a great year. Full of accomplishments and affirmations. We went beyond all Star Council Requirements, and we lived by ZOOM and we died by ZOOM. Listed below are a few of the major accomplishments this year.

- Prayer and Eucharist. We have documented over 3200 hours of prayer through the Faith in Action Program with rosaries, reflections, the Silver Rose, the Consecration of the Holy Family, Into the Breach, Holy Hour, Novenas for Life, and our Monthly Family Rosary program. We had a Eucharist celebration with a Bishop, Pastor, Chaplain Emeritus and Deacon and God willing a Eucharist celebration for fathers to renew their wedding vows on June 19th.
- Food and Pandemic Leadership. We will have collected over 3000 pounds of food through the Food for Families Program, packed over 2000 bags of groceries through the Social Concerns and Catholic Charities Emergency Food Network during this Columbian year. Through the LISTOS Emergency Preparedness Initiative we packed over 11,000 kits impacting over 50,000 people and 56 parishes throughout the diocese.
- **Programs and the Squires/Roses Project.** At the California State Council Convention, two of our efforts-the Family and Life were placed in the top ten programs in the state. DGK and Program Director Sage Chavez reports we have already been notified that we won the Columbian Award from the Supreme Council. We have for the last 16 years enjoyed the labor of our Squires/Roses youth and this year is no different-these young people have walked with us through this pandemic in prayer, leadership, and service. Special thanks to our counselors especially Gilbert Alvarez and our parents.
- Communications and Venues. We now have greater communications with ZOOM, our website, and a Crusader in color thanks to Knights Andrew Diaz and Don Watters. We thank the parish staff for their communication support on the parish FB, Website, and bulletin. The council has conducted activities on different 10 parish venues, so we thank Fr. Oscar Mendez, OFM, for allowing us such access.

Mil gracias...It has been a great year and as told Fr. Sam, OFM, we prayed and received many affirmations ...please continue to pray...


