## GRAND KNIGHTS LETTER AUGUST 2021

### ***Worthy Brothers, Families, Squires and Roses,***

The opportunity to assist the Natalie Ibarra, Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, on feeding the youth who were attending the Emmaus Camp which was held July 9-10 in the St. Francis Hall. The Knights supporting the youth were: PGK David Austin, Gilbert Alvarez, DKG Rick Caron, Gary Valente, PGK Dennis Barmettler, Vern Capistran, PGK Andrew Diaz, Bob Conboy, Jesus Lego and Stephen Kimball.

Vern Capistran coordinated the visit by the San Diego Blood Bank Bloodmobile to be in the Mission parking lot on July 11<sup>th</sup>. They received donated blood from 16 parishioners and community individuals. Thank you, Vern, for work.

On Saturday August 7 from 5 PM to 6 PM and Sunday, August 8 from 7:30 AM to 1:30 PM, the Council led by Life Director, David Diaz, Jr, will be collecting baby items to benefit Pathway Health Clinic. Empty baby bottles will be distributed to those attending Masses with the intent they be returned on August 21-22 containing monetary donations. PGK David will be looking for assistance.

On the same Sunday, August 8, the council will hold its first food sale for 2021-2022. While what to sell hasn't been determined, we need volunteers to man the food stations. It will run concurrent to the baby shower event.

Also on August 8<sup>th</sup>, at the 10:00 AM Mass we will have a Corporate Communion. I invite members of the Council and their families to sit together. We sit in the area near the chapel and by the left-hand side of the altar.

With all the activities on August 7 and 8, we will need as many Knights as possible to be at the Serra Center.

On Friday, August 27 the Parish will hold the San Luis Rey Feast Mass and Procession. The Council has been designated to participate in cooking hot dogs and hamburgers and in marching in the parade. The Mass starts at 5:30 followed by the procession which is followed by entertainment and food sales. Please bring your own chairs to sit on and plan on helping with the procession and food sales. As I learn more specifics, I will share the information with you.

The Council does have a real problem with operations. As of this writing, there are several leadership positions still not filled. They are:

### **FAITH DIRECTOR (NEEDS A DIRECTOR)**

The Faith director reports to the program director. The individual appointed to this position should be comfortable discussing and planning faith formation activities for the council. He must be comfortable developing ties with other parish ministries to advance the needs of the whole parish community at the pastor's direction. He works with and understands the information available for faith development through the Order's Catholic Information Service ([kofc.org/cis](http://kofc.org/cis)).

- Appointed by the grand knight, in consultation with the program director.
- Responsible for all Faith based council programs.
- Plans, coordinates, and promotes the required Faith program: Spiritual Reflection.
- Assigns committee chairmen and develops committees that support vocations, parochial services, and religious devotions.
- Collaborates with the program director on which Supreme-recommend programs a council will conduct in the fraternal year and any other Faith programs.

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- Promotes membership in the Father Michael J. McGivney Guild and promotes the cause for his canonization ([fathermcgivney.org](http://fathermcgivney.org)).
- Keeps accurate records of the council's Faith programs for reporting to the program director, along with completing reports for the Refund Vocations Support.
- Program (RSVP), if applicable, and all other Faith programs.
- Provides the council's public relations chairman information about all Faith programs and activities for promotion to the parish and local media.

## **FAMILY DIRECTOR (BK Dennis Barmettler NEEDS A CO-DIRECTOR)**

The Family director reports to the program director. The individual appointed to this position should work to strengthen and nourish wholesome home life through the sponsorship of activities involving entire families, even when the age range of family members vary. This person should work to stimulate togetherness within families. He should be comfortable discussing and planning family programs that support and encourage service to the community and faith formation of council and parish families.

- Appointed by the grand knight, in consultation with the program director.
- Responsible for all Family based council programs.
- Plans, coordinates, and promotes the required Family program: Consecration to the Holy Family.
- Assigns committee chairmen and develops committees that support family programs such as the many Supreme-recommended Family programs in the Faith in Action program model.
- Supports the areas of education and religious devotions of families, recreational activities and remembrance of fallen brother knights, and support of their widows and families members.
- Collaborates with the program director on which Supreme-recommend programs a council will conduct in the fraternal year and any other Family programs.
- Keeps accurate records of the council's Family programs for reporting to the program director, along with completing reports for the Food for Families and Family of the Month/Year program, if applicable, and all other family programs.
- Provides the council's public relations chairman information about all Family programs and activities for promotion to the parish and local media.
- Must complete all required safe environment training and must also pass a background check. Additionally, he must adhere to all policies and procedures under the Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program.
