REPORT OF SERVICE PROGRAM COMMITTEES

1. Membership Committee

2. Family Committee - Director, BK Gilbert Alvarez

Food for Families will be coming up again, currently scheduled for stapling on Feb. 29th, and collection on weekend of 3/7-3/8. More info to follow at next meeting.

3. Vocation Committee - Director, BK Vern Capistran

The net amount that the Christmas Card Sale made for the Vocation Fund was \$1,300.00. Vern will submit the request for \$500.00 in initial checks to be cut for Franciscan theology students, Bro. Henry and Bro. Tony.





ORDINATION GIFTS:/

The Council traditionally sends an ordination gift to prior recipients of the Vocation Fund support. Since Father Sam Nosata was recently ordained, BK Vern spoke with our pastor, Fr. Vince, about an appropriate present. He suggested we give Fr. Sam a white stole since it could be used in a variety of his priestly services.

PGK Armando Mena made a motion to follow up on this suggestion by researching a source for stoles and setting a \$200.00 limit on the gift. The motion passed on a unanimous voice vote by the Council.

Armando suggested we also present a gift to Fr. Oscar his 30th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. He mentioned that he has a source for handmade chasubles for only \$125.00. This source might also our gift to Fr. Sam to be a chasuble instead of a stole.

The question was raised about where these gifts would fit in the budget. The discussion led to Armando adding an amendment to his motion to contact Financial Secretary Buster Beasley on the question of sourcing funds for the gifts.

PGK Rick Lewis seconded the amendment and it passed on a unanimous voice vote.

REPORT ON CHRISTMAS CARD SALES:

PGK Armando presented the following on behalf of Committee Chair, BK Rick Caron:

\$200.00 was donated to the Squires/Squire Roses for their assistance in selling cards. This left a total of \$1,302.50 for the Vocation Fund.

The larger part of the second order of cards went unsold. This inventory will reduce the costs for next years' sale.

Also, BK Rick Caron is stepping down as Christmas Card Committee chairman. Anyone interested in heading this program for Columbian year 2020-2021 should contact Rick or GK Jorge.

5. Faith Committee - BK Chris Weber - No Report

MORE NEWS ABOUT ST. FRANCIS HALL:

Due to the delayed start of remodeling on the hall, the projected completion date will not be until sometime after March. According to parish Facilities Manager, Don Chadwick, the work should have no impact on our use of the Knights' Hall. Electrical work will not interfere with our scheduled meetings. The question of availability of the Men's' Room during our meetings was raised and will be followed up.





OTHER STANDING COMMITTEES

1. Coats for Kids Committee – Chair, PGK Andrew Diaz

Whether we will do a joint presentation with one or more other councils is still being considered. The date and location of the presentation are also being determined. So far, only about \$200.00 is available to purchase coats. Additional funds may be added from upcoming fundraisers.

2. Community Service Committee

PGK Armando presented the following on behalf of committee chair, PGK David Diaz, Jr:

The 8th annual San Diego Walk for Life will be Saturday, January 18 at 8:30 AM in Balboa Park, starting at 6th & Laurel. Our council will form up a caravan/carpool for those interested in participating. The convoy will leave at about 7:00 AM. T-shirts will be available for \$12.00 at the event. Armando may have a few available for those representing our council at the Walk.

3. First Degree Team - PGK Armando Mena

Our national K of C board has developed a new approach to the traditional member degrees and ceremonies. At the discretion of each council, a new, unified degree and ceremony can replace the current degree rituals. Knights and Knight candidates can now attend a single, simplified ceremony. It has three sections highlighting the Knightly virtues of charity, unity, and fraternity that correspond to the current 1st, 2nd, and 3rd degrees. The new ceremony emphasizes the prayerful nature of the event. In addition, the ceremony eliminates the aspect of secrecy. The unified ceremony is open to the public, with special consideration for the families of those receiving the unified degree.

Armando added that our current degree teams should be able to readily move to the presentation of the unified degree ceremony. As in current practice, while the parts for each team officer can be read, the new, shorter ceremony will be easier to memorize, the preferred mode for running the event.

Further discussion and explanation of these changes will take place at the next Chapter Meeting to be held Saturday, January 11th at St. Joseph Cathedral, 1535 3rd Avenue, San Diego.

4. Shrimpfest – PGK Armando Mena

The annual event will be scheduled for a weekend of Lent, depending on completion of work on St. Francis Hall and availability of the venue. There will be a committee meeting in the Knights' Hall on January 12th. New members for the committee are welcome.
