SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR 2026 – INFORMATION PAGE

The following categories of scholarships may be awarded by Council 3162 annually in June. Scholarships will be awarded on academic and or service by outstanding youth. All awarded scholarships are subject to the amount of funds available or raised by the Council.

CATEGORIES:

SQUIRE:

The Council may award scholarships ranging from \$250, \$500, or \$1000 to college eligible Squire or Squire/Rose or Knight who is a former Squire.

ACADEMIC:

The Council may award \$500 or \$1000 scholarships in the college academic category to eligible applicants selected by the scholarship committee.

RELIGIOUS SCHOOL:

The Council may award scholarships ranging from \$250, \$500, or \$1000 to eligible students attending parochial high school, vocational, or elementary schools.

RELIGIOUS TRAINING STIPEND:

The Council may award partial stipends to Knights who attend religious certification workshops or training for Church service programs or ministries.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must meet ONE of the following requirements:

1. A member of Council 3162.
2. The spouse, child or grandchild of a member of Council 3162 who is in good standing.
3. The spouse, child or grandchild of a deceased member who was in good standing at the time of his death.
4. A member in good standing of the Pope John Paul II Columbian Squire Circle 4974 or St. Clare Squire Rose Circle 0006.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

1. Scholarship Application with a completed verification of Eligibility signed by the Grand Knight and Financial Secretary.
2. Scholastic record for college. Items may include ACT, SAT scores and high school transcripts. Answers to personal questions and three letters of recommendation from persons other than parents or guardians. Continuing college students must present transcripts and current registration.
3. Parochial School applicants must show registration and recommendation from a counselor and or Principal. They need to show a transcript or report card, if applicable.
4. Stipend applicants need to show course registration or expense report and verification by Grand Knight and Financial Secretary.

The Application for College Scholarship will automatically be forwarded to State Council. Students entering a Catholic college or University should see the Grand Knight for the Supreme Council Scholarship information prior to March 1. The deadline for Council 3162 application submission is March 31, 2026
